## Year 11 (Stage 1) & Year 12 (Stage 2) Subject Selection 2022

Dear Parent / Caregivers

The subjects that students choose in Year 11 and 12 can have a significant influence on post school options. Appropriate subject choices make it easier to achieve success. When choosing subjects students should ask themselves what they are interested in, good at, and what subjects they need to achieve career goals.

To help students decide, this term there will be:

- an information session for parents on Monday in week 6
- information sessions for Year 10 students Tuesday Lesson 7 and Wednesday Lesson 1 in week 6
- information sessions for Year 11 students Wednesday Lesson 7 and Thursday Lesson 1 in week 6
- Subject Counselling for students with their parents/caregivers at school in week 7

### **Parent Information Session Week 6 Term 3 – Teaching Block at PASS**

We invite parents of current Year 10 and Year 11 students to an information meeting to be held at the school on Monday 23 August 2021 6:30pm. The purpose is to explain the requirements of the SACE (South Australian Certificate of Education), and give a general outline of the process for the selection of 2022 subjects and discuss strategies on how parents can support their children in the final years of study. We will endeavour to record the session for those unable to attend, in order for them to watch later.

Parent Booking Guide



PASS **Subject Counselling** for students entering Year 10, 11 and 12 in 2022

Go to [www.schoolinterviews.com.au](http://www.schoolinterviews.com.au) and follow these simple instructions.

To make a booking, please enter the event code:

 

On the Home Screen, click on "make a booking"  
Then on the next screen enter the code *p2det* (no spaces) and press "Go"



## Enter your details

- email address
- parents name
- parents phone number
- students current Homegroup or Year Level
- the number of students being booked for and their name (s)

(You may be sent an email with a token code number to enter to verify your email address. If so please check your email to collect this code. This email may be sent to your clutter or junk folder instead of your inbox depending on your internet/email providers settings).



## Select the Year Level

Select the Year Level your child will be going into next year



## Tick an available appointment time from any of the times listed that suit you best (8am-6pm)

MONDAY 30/8 – For current Year 11 students going into Year 12 in 2022  
TUESDAY 31/8 – For current Year 10 students going into Year 11 in 2022  
WEDNESDAY 15/9 - For current Year 9 students going into Year 10 in 2022  
(information for year 9s will be coming out in the next few weeks)

There will be up to 4 staff members (Student Wellbeing Counsellor & Assistant Principals) available each day, therefore up to 4 students with their parents/caregivers can be counselled in each time slot. Click on a suitable time from any of the 4 rows listed. The interview should go for approximately 15-20 minutes.

## THEN PRESS THE GREEN GO



On the next screen it lists your appointment time and options to update or change the details.

When you click **Finished**, your interview time will be emailed to you automatically. If you do not receive your email immediately –
