The Certificate I in Hospitality course will provide you with the skills and knowledge to become competent in routine tasks in various hospitality settings such as restaurants, hotels, motels, catering operations, clubs, pubs, cafes and coffee shops.

This qualification allows individuals to develop basic skills and knowledge to prepare for work. They may undertake a range of simple tasks under close supervision. Possible jobs include kitchen hand, coffee shop assistant, and waiter.
