

Certificate II in Retail Make Up and Skin Care is suitable for people wanting to work in a salon or store demonstrating and selling skin care products and providing personal make up services. They perform general retail functions including the processing of transactions and housekeeping.

Students learn about skin care, day and evening makeup, special occasion, wedding and photographic make-up. This course is designed as an entry level program for the Make Up, Fashion and Beauty Industry.

Competencies: A total of fifteen (15) units of competency must be achieved for the full certificate (10 core and 5 elective) providing up to 55 SACE Credits at Stage 1.
