

Students gain a greater understanding of the hairdressing/barbering industry, together with pre-employment skills in hairdressing and retail related industries.

This qualification is suitable for learners who want to provide salon assistance in a hairdressing salon/barber shop.

Students complete hands on experience in our simulated salon, which enables them to understand the industry whilst developing skills which they will have for life.

Competencies: A total of twelve (12) units of competency must be achieved for the full certificate (8 core and 4 elective) providing up to 45 SACE Credits at Stage 1. As this is an introductory course the highlighted units will be available in 2018.
